

National Park Service Anniversary

The National Park Service was created 85 years ago today, on August 25, 1916, *“to conserve the scenery and the natural and historic objects and the wild life therein and to provide for the enjoyment of the same in such manner and by such means as will leave them unimpaired for the enjoyment of future generations.”* To celebrate, park entry is free today.

This is your receipt for reentry to Zion National Park through August 31.

This pass must be in your possession for reentry. The tunnel escort fee for oversized vehicles and camping fees remain in effect.
