ORDER NO. 393

The attention of all interested branches of the department is again called to the fact that Mr. Jesse L. Nusbaum, Superintendent, Mesa Verde National Park, is designated as the Departmental Archaeologist. All requests for permission to explore prehistoric ruins on the public domain, in the national parks, and on Indian reservations, are, under existing orders, referred to him for report. The request should be routed through the Office of the Secretary, and no permission will be given to any scientific or other party to carry on investigations or remove prehistoric relics without the consent of the Secretary and in accordance with interdepartmental regulations on the subject.
