


# LEICESTER B. HOLLAND PRIZE 2013

- Field records
- Dimensioning and annotation

Holland Prize is an annual competition that recognizes the best single-sheet measured drawing of a historic building, site, or structure prepared by an individual(s) to the standards of the Historic American Buildings Survey (HABS), Historic American Engineering Record (HAER), or the Historic American Landscapes Survey (HALS). The prize honors Leicester B. Holland, a founder of HABS and the first curator of the Library of Congress HABS collection.
