

The Heritage Documentation Programs division of the National Park Service seeks applications from qualified students for summer employment documenting historic sites and structures of architectural, landscape and technological significance throughout the country. Duties involve on-site fieldwork and preparation of historical reports or measured and interpretive drawings for the HABS/HAER/HALS collection at the Prints and Photographs Division of the Library of Congress. Project duration is twelve weeks, beginning in late May or early June. Salaries range from approximately \$5,800 to \$10,700 for the summer, depending on job responsibility, location of the project, and level of experience. **The application deadline is February 16, 2012.**
