- 1-page "statement of intent" from the applicant stating what he/she hopes to achieve from a residency at Hubbell Trading Post National Historic Site.

Submit appropriate examples of recent work:

- Provide 6 to 10 photographic images for review. We accept the following visual formats: Color prints, CD-jpg files, and/or DVD-jpg files. Label prints with artist's name, title, medium, and size (height by width). Indicate the top of the image for color prints with a T. Attach an inventory sheet of the images with additional written descriptive information.
- One VHS videotape, CD (mp3 file format) or DVD readable using Microsoft Media Player for video or performance artists.
- If you are a writer, one copy of a brief (maximum 6 pages) excerpt from a manuscript, short story, article, poetry, etc.
