


The national lakeshore was established in 1966 to preserve for the educational, inspirational, and recreational use of the public, certain portions of the Indiana Dunes and other areas of scenic, scientific, and historic interest and recreational value in the state of Indiana. About two million annual visitors enjoy the park's 15,000 acres of wetlands, prairies, sand dunes, oak savannas, forests, and historic sites. The park's beach hugs the southern shore of Lake Michigan from Gary, Indiana, to Michigan City, Indiana. For more information, visit www.nps.gov/indu.

The Bailly/Chellberg and Little Calumet River Trails reveal the rich natural diversity that has drawn people to this area for over 10,000 years. Hike through a forest dominated by maple, beech, basswood, and oak trees. Follow a stretch of the Little Calumet River, once a critical transportation route for early regional travelers. Explore the recently restored Mnoké Prairie for a glimmer of the vast stretches of pre-settlement grasslands.

Visit the Bailly Homestead and Chellberg Farm to glimpse how families farmed and adapted to development in northwest Indiana.

Each season on this trail reveals a different mystery. Come back often!

Information & Safety

Trail Length – 3.7 miles
(Bailly/Chellberg loop: 2.1 miles;
Little Calumet loop: 1.6 miles).

Average Hike Time – 45 minutes to
2 hours.

Trail Surface – Packed soil and wood
chips; stairs.

Difficulty – Easy to moderate; mostly
flat, but with some steep grades and
stairs.

Accessibility – Partial accessibility to
the Chellberg Farm only.

Hours – Open sunrise to 30 minutes
past sunset.

Pets – Pets permitted on a leash
(6' or shorter).

Stay on the trail to protect wildlife and
yourself.

Avoid poison ivy along trail edges.

No bicycles or motorized vehicles
allowed.


No littering, hunting, disturbing
wildlife or picking plants.

Be prepared for changing weather
conditions.

Use insect repellent, wear long
sleeves, and tuck long pants into socks
to avoid ticks.
