This new program invites Boy Scouts to engage in hands-on activities geared towards the American Heritage Badge requirements while interacting with Civil War reenactors and park rangers from the National Park Service. Scouts participating in this program will also earn a Scout Ranger patch.

This encampment is **limited to 50 scouts** on a first-come, first-serve basis. Each Troop, Pack or Den is responsible for registering for this event through James A. Garfield National Historic Site and completing whatever paperwork is required from the Boy Scouts of America. **Deadline for Registration is September 1, 2011.**
