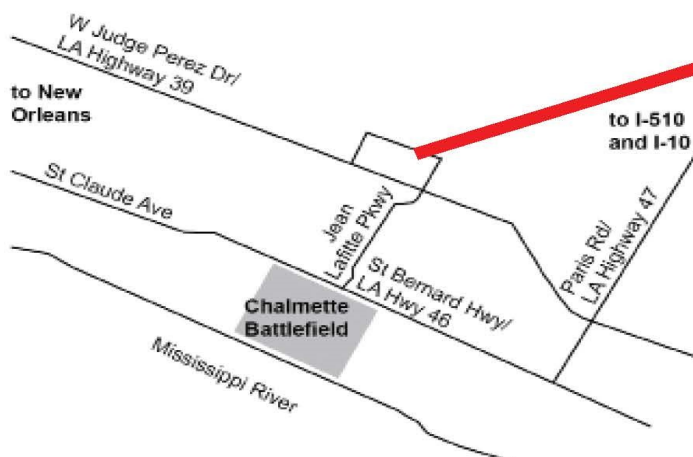
FRIDAY & SATURDAY, JANUARY 11 & 12 9:00A.M.–3:30P.M. FREE

ALL public parking for Friday and Saturday battlefield events is at St. Bernard Parish Government Center, 8201 West Judge Perez Drive, Chalmette (see map—parking in rear of center). Restrooms, hospitality area, and tourism information available inside center. Free shuttles (wheelchair accessible) run continually between public parking area and battlefield; travel time each way approximately 20 minutes.

- 8:45 a.m. first shuttle to battlefield leaves parking area
- 2:30 p.m. last shuttle to battlefield leaves parking area
- 3:30 p.m. last shuttle to parking area leaves battlefield
