

"One day, the lady from the next farm came to visit, and Mama commented on how many tramps she had helped that week. Mrs. Bacon said, 'Well, I'm thankful that they never come in *my* yard.'

The next time we had some of the vagrant visitors, Mama asked why they had stopped at our house and not the others. After some hesitation, one of them said, 'Ma'am, we have a set of symbols that we use, to show the attitude of each family along the road. The post on your mailbox is marked to say that you don't turn people away or mistreat us.' After they were gone, we went out and found some unobtrusive scratches; Mama told us not to change them."






Jimmy Carter's paintings depict beloved things: friends, family and scenes from nature. Above from left to right: cabin, belted kingfisher, and magnolia flowers.






