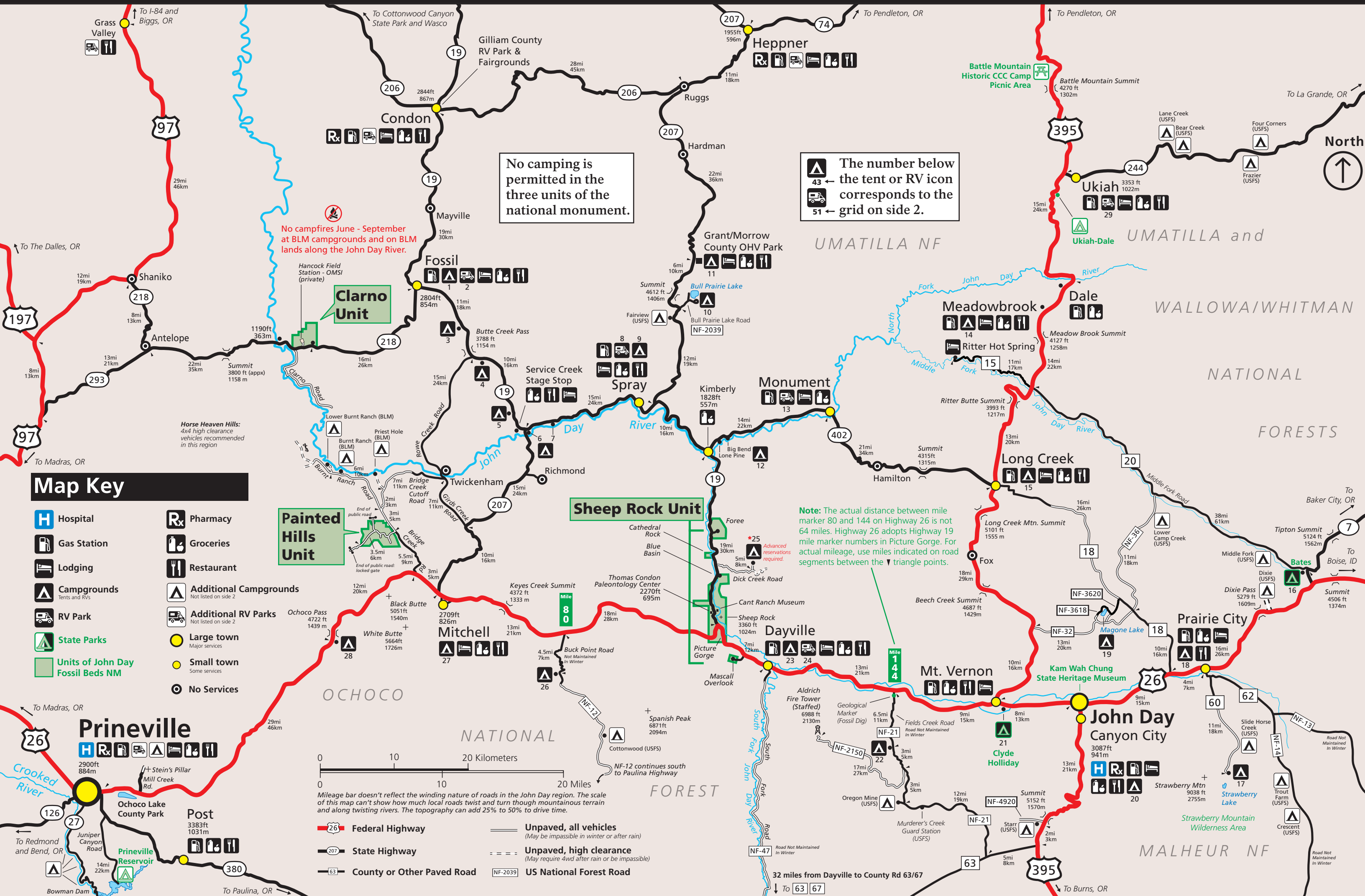


# John Day Regional Map: Camping & Services



No camping is permitted in the three units of the national monument.

The number below the tent or RV icon corresponds to the grid on side 2.

No campfires June - September at BLM campgrounds and on BLM lands along the John Day River.

Note: The actual distance between mile marker 80 and 144 on Highway 26 is not 64 miles. Highway 26 adopts Highway 19 mile marker numbers in Picture Gorge. For actual mileage, use miles indicated on road segments between the triangle points.

# Availability of Services



Thank you for supporting local Oregon businesses.

Mercantiles in area towns carry most essential items. Supermarkets and pharmacies are available in John Day and Prineville. WiFi may be available at some local businesses for customers. Cell service is carrier dependent. Do not expect coverage between towns due to the mountainous terrain. Auto repair is located in most towns as well as the Dale Service Station.

Most services shown on the map are open 7 days/wk during the summer season but some may be closed 1-2 days/wk. Call ahead.

Purchase fuel before 5pm. There are no 24 hour gas stations in the region except Prineville. Gas stations close between 5pm and 8pm. Motorists may not pump their own gas in Oregon. Some gas stations have reduced hours on Sundays. Towns labeled with the gas station icon *should* have fuel available seven days per week in the summer.

## Can I camp in John Day Fossil Beds National Monument?

No camping is allowed inside the three units of the monument but plenty of commercial and public options are available nearby. For dispersed camping on public lands, check with the Bureau of Land Management or the Forest Service.
