



Planning Process for John Fitzgerald Kennedy National Historic Site

The Kennedy NHS needs a strategic plan to enable the park to address key operational issues, and to plan for long-term preservation of the historic resource while supporting visitor use, expanding useful partnerships, and being a responsible member of the Brookline community. The plan will also include an evaluation of the environmental impacts related to the plan.

A planning team made up of the managers of the Kennedy NHS, NPS planning staff, and consultants is preparing the strategic plan. We welcome public input throughout the planning process, to identify issues, to make suggestions, and to respond to and comment on proposed management alternatives when the Draft Plan is made publicly available.
