



# Overflow Camping – North of Joshua Tree National Park

## Dispersed Camping

Public lands managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) offer free dispersed camping north of Highway 62 and Joshua Tree National Park. Camping is allowed anywhere in the indicated area except within 300 feet (91 m) of roadways. There are no developed facilities

in dispersed camping areas: no restrooms, no water, no trash collection. Bring what you need and pack out all your trash. All vegetation, living or dead, is protected by law. Campfires require a permit, available from BLM offices or at <http://www.preventwildfireca.org/Campfire-Permit>

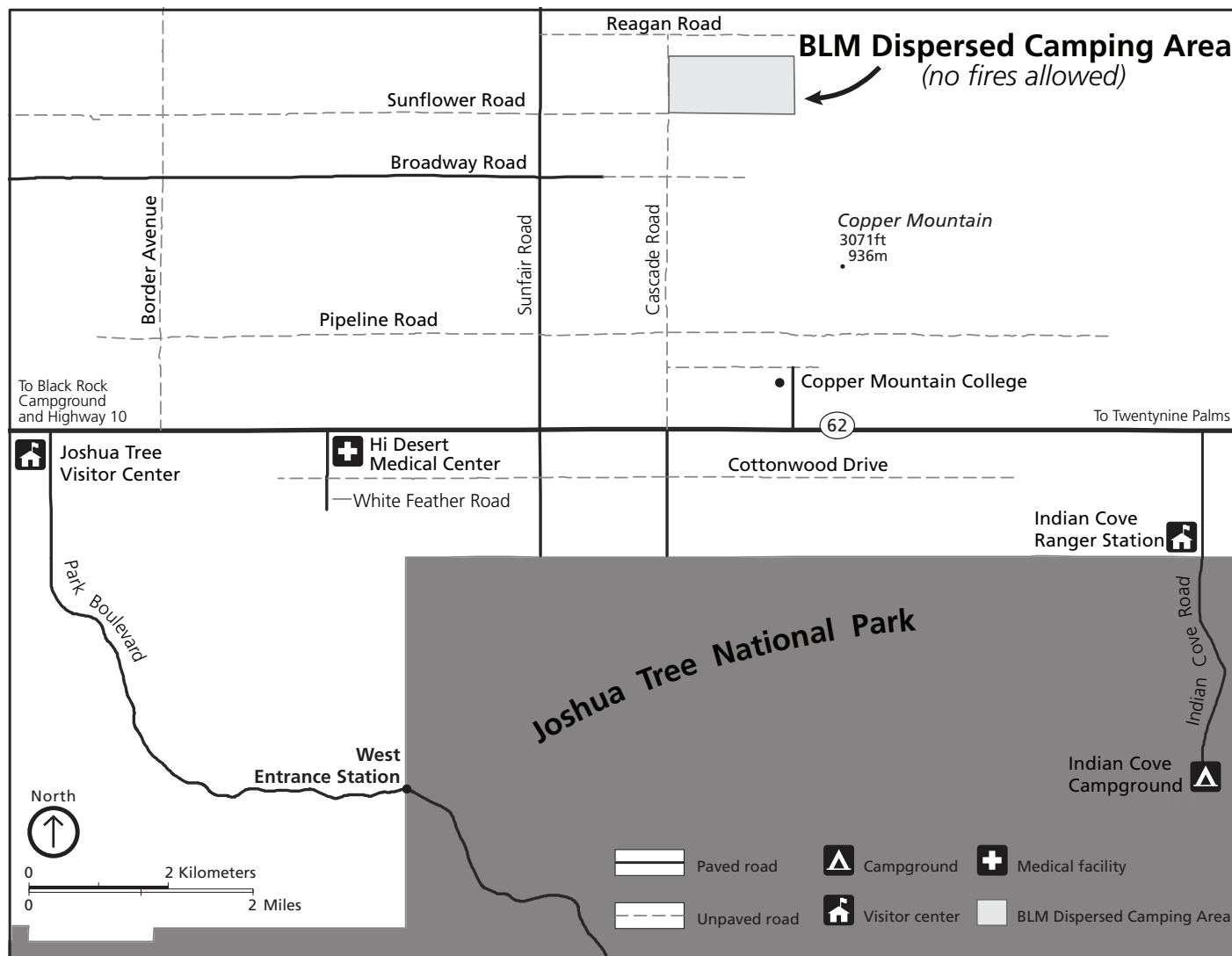

## Dispersed Camping

Public lands managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) offer many opportunities for free dispersed camping close to the South Entrance. Camping is allowed anywhere in the dispersed camping areas shown, except within 300 feet (91 m) of roadways or if there are signs marking the area closed to camping.

There are no developed facilities in dispersed camping areas: no restrooms, no water, no trash collection. Bring what you need and pack out all your trash. All vegetation, living or dead, is protected by law. Campfires require a permit, available from BLM offices or at <http://www.preventwildfireca.org/Campfire-Permit>

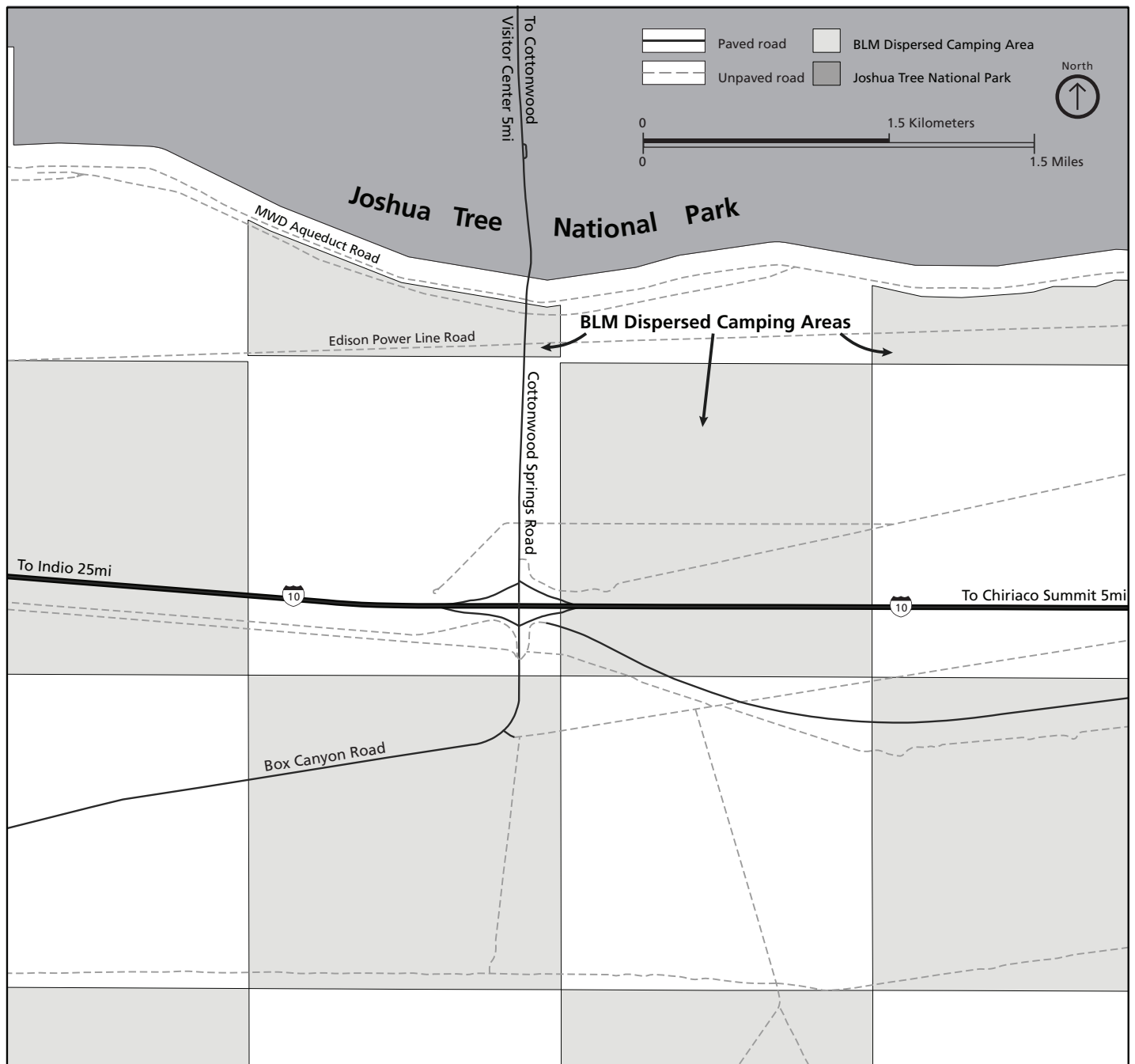
