

Trails & Rails is a national partnership between Amtrak and the National Park Service. In California, the program is administered by the Juan Bautista de Anza National Historic Trail and the South Coast Railroad Museum of Goleta, Calif. Docents must be at least 18, have sufficient body mobility, and able to lift 35 pounds. Commitment: two 1-day trips per month (April thru August). No cost to participate on train, though docents are responsible for their own parking or public transport to train station.
