### **2014 Superintendent's Compendium for Pu'uhonua o Hōnaunau and Kaloko-Honokōhau National Historical Parks**

The Superintendent's Compendium is a supplemental document that addresses specific management needs and concerns of an individual national park area. The compendium helps provide for the enjoyment, use and protection of the parks. The compendium is authorized by Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Parts 1 through 7, which allow the superintendent to establish these regulations. The Superintendent's Compendium is updated at least annually to continually address specific management needs of the park. These regulations apply in addition to the criminal laws of the United States and the regulations contained in Title 36 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Copies of the Compendiums are available at the Parks' Headquarters (addresses below) and at the Parks' Visitor Centers.

Both Pu'uhonua o Hōnaunau and Kaloko-Honokōhau NHP's Superintendents compendiums have been updated for 2014. Public comments, questions and input may be submitted in writing to the Superintendent at the address below.
