News Flash!!! Kalaupapa Landfill Closing July 30th, 2010

Important: no food waste or aerosol cans in your trash!!!

Recycle Center Will Take Responsibility of Trash Collection for the Entire Settlement

Once the Kalaupapa landfill is closed, the recycling center will take on the responsibilities of all the trash that Kalaupapa produces. The recycling center will compact all of the recyclables and compost all of the food waste.

Regular Collection Times Will Continue

The collection times for trash, recyclables, compost, household and green waste will continue to be Mondays and Thursdays.

Remember to Separate Your Recyclables

Please remember to separate your recyclables. When containers such as empty beer or soda cans are thrown in with paper products the paper becomes wet and cannot be processed properly. We ask you to separate your paper from your containers.

Pack In Pack Out

If you are hosting visitors, please ask them to take their trash with them when they leave.

We Will Pick Up Household Waste, Appliances, and Batteries

If you have any household waste, appliances and batteries, we will pick them up for you if you leave them on the curbside by your house.

Do Not Take Your Trash to the Recycling Center

We will pick up any trash that you have. Please put it out on the curbside by your house.
