Kenai Fjords National Park Winter 2017-18: Snowmobile Use in the Exit Glacier Developed Area

Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 13.1318 defines Exit Glacier Developed Area (EGDA) As: 1. From the park boundary to Exit Glacier Campground Entrance Road, all park areas within 350 meters (383 yards) of the centerline of the Exit Glacier Road; 2. From Exit Glacier Campground Entrance Road to the end of the main paved trail, all park areas within 500 meters (546 yards) of any paved surface; or 3. All park areas within 300 meters (328 yards) of the terminus of Exit Glacier.

Title 36 CFR 13.1326 states: The use of snowmachines is prohibited within the EGDA, excepta. On Herman Leirer Road; b. In parking areas; c. On a designated route through the Exit Glacier Campground to Exit Creek: d. Within Exit Creek; and e. For NPS administrative activities.
