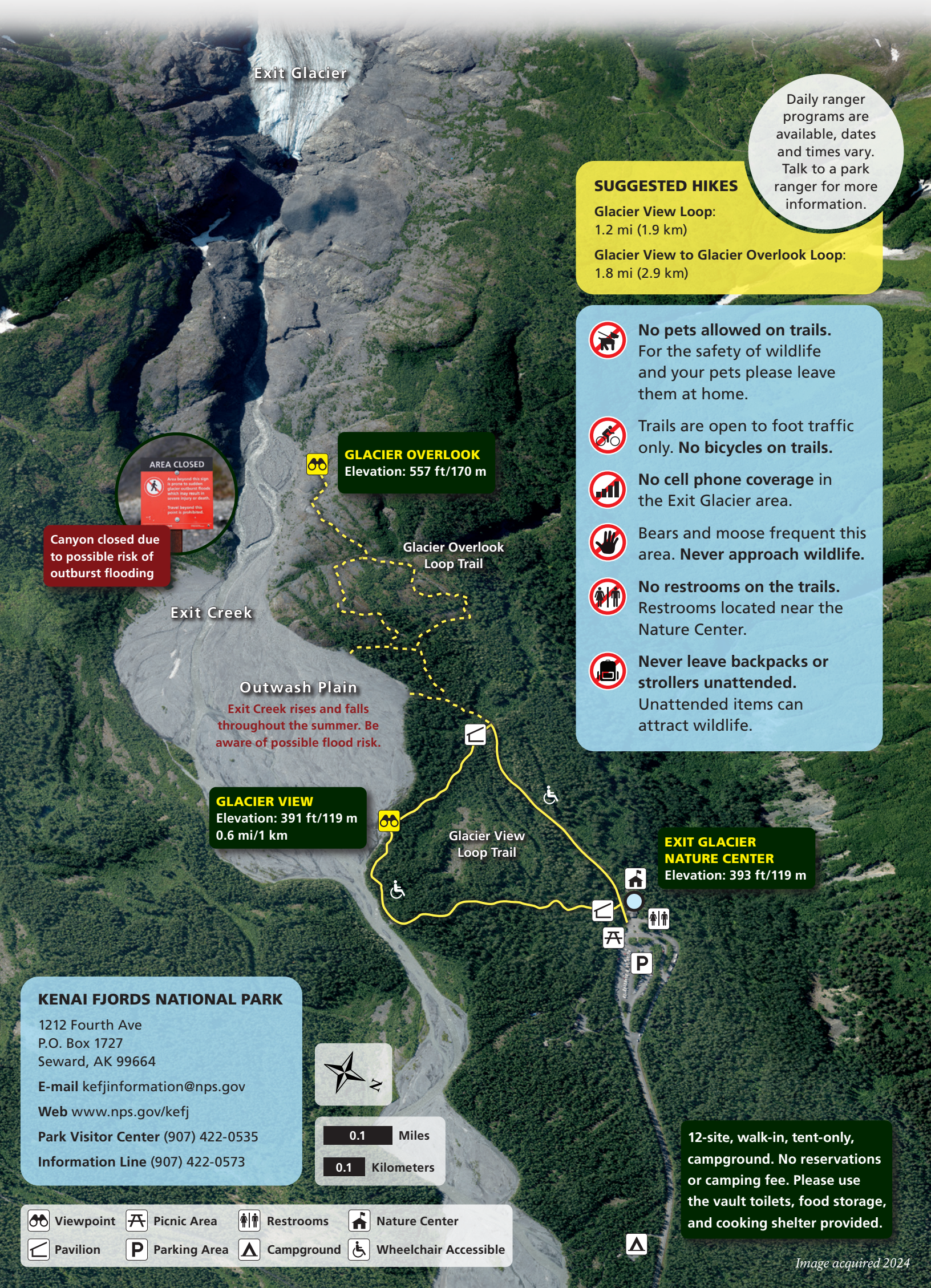




Exit Glacier Nature Center and Trails

GETTING TO EXIT GLACIER: At mile 3.7 of the Seward Highway, turn onto Herman Leirer Road. Travel 8.6 miles to the Exit Glacier parking lot. There are no fees to access the park. Trails are accessible day and night.



Daily ranger programs are available, dates and times vary. Talk to a park ranger for more information.

SUGGESTED HIKES

- Glacier View Loop:
1.2 mi (1.9 km)
- Glacier View to Glacier Overlook Loop:
1.8 mi (2.9 km)

- No pets allowed on trails.** For the safety of wildlife and your pets please leave them at home.
- Trails are open to foot traffic only. **No bicycles on trails.**
- No cell phone coverage** in the Exit Glacier area.
- Bears and moose frequent this area. **Never approach wildlife.**
- No restrooms on the trails.** Restrooms located near the Nature Center.
- Never leave backpacks or strollers unattended.** Unattended items can attract wildlife.

AREA CLOSED

Area beyond this sign is prone to sudden glacier outburst floods which may result in severe injury or death. Travel beyond this point is prohibited.
