Geocaching is a global scavenger hunt, where participants use a smartphone or a GPS device to find hidden containers called geocaches.

This twenty cache trail will lead you on an adventure through Keweenaw National Historical Park and many of its partner Heritage Sites. Use this passport to record the key to crack the cypher. The sites and park work together to preserve and interpret the region's copper mining history. From wilderness areas to historic sites, you will explore many amazing places on your journey.
