PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

A BUG'S LIFE

Hike along with Ranger Kenzie to discover the vital role insects play throughout the monument. Meet at the Big Painted Cave trailhead.

FLEENER CHIMNEYS: HIKE & HISTORY

Join Ranger Ashley for a short hike and history of this unique volcanic eruption. Meet at Fleener Chimneys parking lot.

HISTORY OF HUMANITY

Join Ranger Emily to learn about the people who have lived here, explored here, and continue to maintain the area. Meet at Mushpot Cave.

SCAT HAPPENS

Join Ranger Alison at the visitor center to learn about animal scat and the important role it plays in our monument.

WALK INTO THE WILD

Hike alongside Ranger Mary through the wilderness of Lava Beds and learn about the monument's wild side! Meet for this tour at the bathrooms in the A Loop of the campground.

WAY OF THE MODOCS

Immerse yourself in the traditions of Modoc culture with Ranger Emily as she talks about the Modoc ways of life and tools used by their ancestors. Meet for this talk at Petroglyph Point.

WHEN CULTURES COLLIDE

Hike with Ranger Jeanette through the lava fortress where Modocs held off the U.S. Army during the Modoc War. Bring sturdy shoes, a hat, sunscreen, and water. Meet at Captain Jack's Stronghold.

EVENING PROGRAM: ASTRONOMY

Learn how stars inspire stories and have stories to tell of their own at the amphitheater with Ranger Mary. Campfire storytelling to follow!

CAVE TOURS

- Meet at the visitor center at 2:00 pm (unless otherwise noted)
- There is a maximum limit—pick up a reservation card at the visitor center the day of your tour!
- All cave tours last 1-1 ½ hours
- Closed-shoes, flashlights, and head protection required
- Lights and hard hats are available at the visitor center
- Cave difficulty varies. Inquire at the visitor center.
