

Join The Lake Mead AD Hand Crew!



The Fire Management Office of the Lake Mead National Recreation is currently looking for hard working and motivated people who are interested working on call as an AD employee on a 20 person hand crew. An AD employee is someone who is called, usually in an emergency, to respond to an incident or increase staffing levels.

Some of the types of incidents that you could expect to respond to are: Wildland Fires, Search and Rescues, EMS Responses, Prescribed Fires, Natural Disaster Relief and virtually anything else that we are called upon to assist with.

As an AD you can assist in the suppression of any of the over 100 fires in Southern Nevada each year. Lake Mead also averages over 60 SAR calls, 350 EMS calls and several prescribed



fires each year! You would also be available to assist with wildfires and other responses throughout the entire nation!



We do not require any previous training and we will provide all the required training at no cost! All we require is the completion of a physical fitness test we call The Pack Test, of which we will also administer. The Pack Test consists of a 3 mile long hike on level terrain with a 45 pound weight vest and must be completed within 45 minutes.

AD pay rates may vary based upon qualifications but rates begin at \$14.20 an hour. AD's also receive certain pay entitlements such as travel reimbursement and food and hotel per diem while traveling out of state. However AD employees do not receive overtime pay and other pay differentials associated with being a federal employee.
