EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER - AMENDED
CN #14-007

REISSUED AUGUST 7, 2014

Pursuant to the authority vested in me as Superintendent, Lake Mead National Recreation Area, National Park Service, I hereby declare that the portion of Lake Mead National Recreation Area known as Kingman Wash shall be temporarily closed to all access, hiking and other recreational uses.

Kingman Wash is temporarily closed beginning at Highway 93 and Approved Road 70, and all of Approved Road 70 to Kingman Wash. The land closure is due to storm damages. The shoreline and beach area of Kingman Wash is still accessible from the lake and remains open to the public.

The area closed in the interest of public and employee safety is indicated on the drawing shown below, which is hereby made a part of this order. This temporary closure is being amended and effective immediately until August 14, 2014.
