EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER
ISSUED April 18, 2019
CN #19-002

EFFECTIVE May 15, 2019

Pursuant to the authority vested in me as Superintendent, Lake Mead National Recreation Area, National Park Service, I hereby declare that the portion of Lake Mead National Recreation Area known as the Goldstrike Canyon shall be temporarily closed to all access, hiking and other recreational uses.

Goldstrike Canyon is temporarily closed at Approved Road 75A (Goldstrike Canyon Road) and the parking area at the trailhead down the trail toward the river to the Bureau of Reclamation boundary. The hot springs near Goldstrike Canyon are still accessible from the river and remain open to the public.

The areas to be closed in the interest of public and employee safety are indicated on the drawing shown below, which is hereby made a part of this order. This temporary closure will begin May 15, 2019 and will continue through to September 30, 2019.
