EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER
CN #14-003

April 9, 2014

Pursuant to the authority vested in me as Superintendent, Lake Mead National Recreation Area, National Park Service, I hereby declare that the portion of Lake Mead National Recreation Area known as St. Thomas, Overton Beach and Stewarts Point and adjacent areas shall be temporarily closed. Individuals with personal property at Stewarts Point will be allowed access during the closure and will be provided safety information from rangers on-site.

Northshore Road and the land to the west of Northshore Road remain open.

The Bureau of Land Management Southern Nevada District Office and the National Park Service's Lake Mead National Recreation Area are taking steps to resolve a long-standing cattle trespass on federal lands.

The area to be closed in the interest of public safety is indicated on the drawing shown below, which is hereby made a part of this order. This temporary closure will begin April 9, 2014, and continue through April 10, 2014.
