Glass beverage containers and Styrofoam products are not allowed at Lake Mead NRA.

Emergencies

Fires

Fire restrictions are in effect. Campfires are prohibited in the backcountry and where signed. Campfires and barbeques are permitted in park campgrounds and on most lake shores where natural vegetation is at least 100 feet from the water. Please don't damage park trees. Firewood may be purchased at marinas and most local grocery stores. Fireworks are illegal in the park.

Firearms

Federal law allows people who can legally possess firearms under applicable federal, state and local laws to possess them in the park. Firearms are prohibited in federal buildings, such as visitor centers and ranger stations. It is the responsibility of visitors to understand and comply with all applicable state, local and federal firearm laws before entering the park. Target shooting is prohibited.

Pets

Pets are allowed on all trails and beaches within the park unless there is a sign that says otherwise. Pets must be under physical control on a leash no longer than six feet at all times. Pets are not allowed to be left in cars at Lake Mead NRA and Hoover Dam. Please consider your pet's needs for
