Green Practices

Check the Green Ranger tips that you try to practice every day:

- I don't throw away aluminum, plastic and glass bottles or paper. I recycle!
- I turn off lights and electronic devices when I am not in the room. I save resources. I *Turn it Off!*
- Whenever I see litter. I *Pick it Up!*
- I ride my bike, walk, or carpool to school. *Powered by Humans!*
- Whenever I shop I bring my own cloth bag. No paper or plastic!
- I dress warmly instead of turning up the heat. I'm *Energy Efficient!*
- I bring lunch in reusable containers, and use utensils from home. I Reuse!
- I donate my old clothes and toys, I *Pass It On*, and buy used.
