




Lassen Volcanic National Park Volcano Club

The Lassen Volcano Club membership is open to all ages. To qualify for membership, complete at least seven of the activities listed below. Share your findings with a ranger at the Kohm Yah-mah-nee Visitor Center or Loomis Museum (summer only).

1. Visit one of Lassen's hydrothermal areas (Sulphur Works, Bumpass Hell, or Devils Kitchen). Describe what you see.
2. List two safety rules everyone should follow when visiting Lassen's hydrothermal areas.
3. Hike the Devastated Area Trail. Imagine you are a newspaper reporter. Write a short story about the eruption of Lassen Peak from what you learned from the trailside exhibits.
4. List three different rock types found at Lassen Volcanic National Park.
5. Explain how the huge rocks in the Devastated Area got from the top of Lassen Peak to where they sit today.
6. Name four other national parks which contain volcanic features.
7. Visit the USGS seismic exhibit in the Loomis Museum. Explain how scientists monitor volcanic activity at Lassen.
8. Describe the four different types of volcanoes found both at Lassen Volcanic and around the world.
9. Visit the Kohm Yah-mah-nee Visitor Center exhibits and list three volcanoes in the Cascade Range.
10. List three ways we can protect and preserve the volcanic features found here in Lassen Volcanic National Park.
11. Download and take the Lassen Peak crater audio tour. Visualize one of the stories about the eruption and write about the experience.
12. Attend one ranger-led program. Write down something you learned.
13. List two reasons why the study of volcanoes is important.
14. Climb to the top of the Cinder Cone. Describe the cinder cone, its rocks and other volcanic features of the area.
