

In accordance with regulations and the delegated authority provided in Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations ("36 CFR"), Chapter 1, Parts 1-7, authorized by Title 16 United States Code, Section 3, the following regulatory provisions are established for the proper management, protection, government and public use of those portions of Lassen Volcanic National Park under the jurisdiction of the National Park Service. Unless otherwise stated, these regulatory provisions apply in addition to the requirements contained in 36 CFR, Chapter 1, Parts 1-7.

36 CFR §1.5 – VISITING HOURS, PUBLIC USE LIMITS, CLOSURES, AND AREA DESIGNATIONS FOR SPECIFIC USE OR ACTIVITIES

The following road, trails and park facilities are closed

Lassen Volcanic National Park Highway: The road through the Park is open. Traffic control and delays should be expected from Manzanita Lake to Summit Lake.

Campgrounds and other Park Facilities

Crags Campground is closed

Lost Creek Campground is closed

Trail Closures

- Summit Lake to Twin Lakes is closed east of Echo Lake.
- The trail leading north to Little Bear Lake is closed at its junction with the Echo Lake trail.
- Hat Lake In-holder Road from Hat Lake to the northern park boundary
- Twin and Cluster Lakes Loop Trail
- Nobles Emigrant Trail from Painted Dunes to the northern park boundary
- The Pacific Crest Trail from Lower Twin Lake to the northern park boundary.
- The section of the Nobles Emigrant trail passing through Crags and Lost Creek Campgrounds.

Area Closures

Areas in Lassen Volcanic National Park that were burned by the Reading Fire will be closed to the public until further notice. These areas contain increased public safety hazards.

This closure includes all of the burned areas bounded by:

- The Lassen Park Highway from the entrance to Craggs Campground to the entrance of Summit Lake South campgrounds the west boundary,
- The northern boundary of Lassen Volcanic National Park as the north boundary,
- The summit of Prospect Peak to the summit of Cinder Cone to the east edge of Lower Twin Lake as the east boundary.
- The east edge of Summit Lake to the east edge of Lower Twin Lake as the south boundary.

This closure also includes all of the burned areas bounded by:

- The Lassen Park Highway from Hat Lake parking Lot to Summit Lake as the north boundary,
- Hat Lake to Cliff Lake,
- North of the Cliff Lake to Summit Lake Trail.

Justification
