



Directions around Lassen Volcanic National Park

The main road through the park, Highway 89 (Hwy 89), is closed to vehicles in the winter. Please follow the directions below to get from the Kohm Yah-mah-nee Visitor Center to the Manzanita Lake area. RVs and vehicles with trailers should take Hwy 36 to Red Bluff, I-5 to Redding, then Hwy 44 to the Manzanita Lake area.

1. Return to Hwy 36, turn right (west) and travel approximately 23 miles to Lanes Valley Road.
 2. Turn right (north) on Lanes Valley Road, before the small town of Paynes Creek.
 3. Take Lanes Valley Road 7 miles to Manton Road (A6) and turn right.
 4. Continue approximately ½ mile over a short, narrow, bridge and make a sharp left onto Wildcat Road.
 5. Wildcat Road turns into Black Butte Road after approximately 5½ miles.
 6. Continue on Black Butte Road for approximately 3½ miles until it ends at Hwy 44.
 7. Turn right (east) onto Hwy 44 and continue approximately 24 miles to the Manzanita Lake Entrance, where Hwy 44 and Hwy 89 intersect. The park entrance will be on your right.
- To reach McArthur-Burney Falls State Park, McCloud, and/or Mt. Shasta, continue north/east on Hwy 44/89 to Hat Creek and then north on Hwy 89.
