Program Descriptions

Bear Necessities

Learn about black bears and how you can help them stay wild in Lassen Volcanic.

Cougar: The American Mountain Lion

This majestic member of the cat family personifies strength, grace, mystery, and the wilderness spirit.

Climate Change at Lassen

Join a ranger for a discussion on the challenges and opportunities related to climate change at the park. What will Lassen look like in 25, 100, or 500 years?

Discovery Center

Check out the exhibits and join a ranger for ongoing short programs and demonstrations on various natural history subjects. Inquire at the Loomis Museum for directions to the Discovery Center.

Early Birds

Take an easy walk and discover the birds of Manzanita Lake.

Flowers in Bloom

Learn to identify wildflowers as you walk with a ranger along scenic Hat Creek and Hat Creek Meadow.

Hands on Science

This family friendly program offers lots of fun and a wide variety of exciting outdoor experiments.

Inside a Volcano at Sulphur Works

Join a ranger and discover what drives Sulphur Works and learn about the secrets that make its features unique.

Junior Firefighters

If you are 7 to 12 years old, you can discover wildfire's role in our national parks and become a junior firefighter.

Junior Rangers

If you are 7 to 12 years old, you can become a junior ranger by joining in this fun adventure. Learn about the park through games and outdoor activities.

Lakes and Ponds

Join a park ranger for a casual walk to explore the hidden wonders of a lake and two ponds.

Lassen's Dark Sky

Explore the night sky and learn how to spot star groups like Swan and Scorpion with your naked eye then get an up close view of celestial wonders through a telescope.

Manzanita Lake Evening Program

Join a park ranger for an evening program about the park's natural or cultural history.

Moon Over Lassen

A brief look at Earth's nearest neighbor. Explore the origins, distances, sizes, and features (craters!) of our next door neighbor.

On the Wild Side

Discover some of the "wilder sides" of the park during this program. Topics vary from the natural to the cultural history of the park.

On Top of a Volcano

You've made it to the top of Lassen! Catch your breath and learn more about the history of Lassen Peak. Bring your lunch and meet a ranger at the top of Lassen Peak.

Our Magnetic Sun

View the sun through a specially designed telescope and learn about our closest star.

Pioneers

It's 1853 along the wagon road called the Nobles Emigrant Trail. You will visit a pioneer camp and meet some rugged travelers who tell stories about their journey to California.

Secrets to Survival

Up to 40 feet of snow in winter and fires as hot as 1200° F in summer. Lassen is a harsh place to call home! How do plants and animals survive? Find out about their Secrets to Survival, and how their survival will be challenged as Lassen's climate continues to change.

Sense of Wonder

A special program for young children ages 4 to 6. Emphasis on outdoor activities that promote nature awareness through the use of the senses. Parents are welcome but not required to attend.

Starry Nights

Join a park ranger for a program on stars, planets, and constellations. Hear stories and learn to locate objects in the sky.

Summit Lake Evening Program

Join a park ranger for a lively program about the natural or cultural history of the park.

Stories in Stone

Join a park ranger and learn about the mysteries and geology of Bumpass Hell.

Volcanoes

Did you know that every mountain in the park is a volcano or part of one? Learn about the geology and volcanic history of the park.
