Onsite Registration: Day of registration will occur at the north end of the Netul Landing from 9 to 9:45 AM. The Netul Landing is located 1.5 mile south of the Fort Clatsop Visitor Center on Fort Clatsop Road.

Cost: There is no cost to participants in the fun run and hike. T-shirts with the scramble logo are available for \$15.

Start Time: 10 AM at the north end of the Netul Landing.

Course:

The fun run will occur rain or shine. There are two courses: a 3-mile loop for runners and walkers or a 6-mile loop for runners only. Both loops cover steep terrain and some of the course is a single track dirt and gravel trail that can be muddy. The rest of course is over boardwalks (which can be slippery) and packed graveled paths. Please make sure you have good shoes with traction. Hikers are welcomed to carry walking sticks. The route is not accessible for a wheelchair or stroller. **Please no pets during the race.**

There will be flaggers at the road crossing until all registered participants cross.

Directions: Netul Landing

From Seaside, OR:

Go north on Hwy 101. Turn right on Alternate (Business) 101--approximately 15 miles north of Seaside. Follow the signs to the Fort Clatsop Visitor Center; turn right onto Fort Clatsop Road. Continue on Fort Clatsop Road 1.5 miles south of Fort Clatsop Visitor Center. The parking lot at the Netul Landing is long and narrow. The entrance gate is at south end.

From Astoria, OR:


