

Requirements


- Walk along at least one of the park's trails.

The Green Pitcher Plant




How do you catch insects?

1. The plant produces nectar which attracts insects.
2. Inside the pitcher, downward pointing hairs keeps the insect from escaping.
3. The insect slips on the inside and falls into the liquid below.
4. The liquid dissolves the insect and nutrients are absorbed by the plant.


