


SUPERINTENDENT'S COMPENDIUM
GLACIER BAY NATIONAL PARK AND PRESERVE

36 CFR 13.1152, Private vessel permits and conditions

For the vessel permit season of June 1 through August 31, advanced notice permits may be applied for no more than 14 days prior to requested date of entry.

Due to the rapidly changing situation regarding the novel coronavirus and the COVID-19 pandemic, and the travel restrictions that have been put into place by the US State Department, the State of Alaska, and the City of Gustavus, the NPS is changing the time frame for reserving Advance-notice permits from 60 days prior to entry to 14 days prior to entry. Once reserved, Advance-notice permits must be confirmed with the park within 48 hours of the scheduled entry. Permits not confirmed through the park's Visitor Information Station by 10:00 a.m. on the scheduled date of entry, will be canceled and made available for reissue.

This provision is approved and will remain in effect until rescinded or superseded.
