RESPONSE TO COMMENTS SUPERINTENDENT'S COMPENDIUM 2023

LAKE CLARK NATIONAL PARK AND PRESERVE

The compendium is a list of designations, closures, permit requirements and other authorizations and restrictions adopted pursuant to authority in the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) applicable to areas administered by the National Park Service (NPS). On January 28, 2023 the NPS published proposed changes for the 2023 compendium and invited public comment on those proposed changes through February 26. A summary of additions, comments and NPS responses is provided below.

Memorialization

2.62(b) Memorialization: designation of areas for scattering of human ashes.

Except as listed below, all areas of the park and preserve are open to scattering of human ashes from cremation without a permit.

- Within ¼ mile of any building or structure, camping areas, occupied campsites, roads, picnic areas, and other park developed areas
- Within the boundaries of the Kijik Archaeological District National Historic Landmark and the Richard L. Proenneke Historic District.
