



LATINO HERITAGE INTERNSHIP

Lowell National Historical Park, Lowell, Massachusetts

The Latino Heritage Internship is a 10 week summer commitment supporting Lowell National Historical Park in expanding community engagement programs and activities. Assist park staff with special events including the Lowell Folk Festival, Meet Us on the Merrimack and the Lowell Summer Music Series Children's Programs.

All necessary training in the processes, local and park history, communication and customer service will be provided.

Living Stipend: \$400/week

Monthly Housing Stipend: \$800

Time frame: 10 weeks. June 1 – August 7, 2015 – Flexible start date.

August 3-7, 2015 will be with national participants in Washington, DC.

Requirements:

- Must be between 18-35 years of age and of Latino Heritage
- Successful candidate must pass a federal background check
- Must be available 40 hours per week including some weekends, holidays and evenings.
- Outgoing personality who enjoys working as a member of a team and enjoys meeting new people.
- Must be enrolled as a current undergraduate or undergraduate student or graduated within the past year.

Skills Desired:

- Ability to communicate in English. Other languages are beneficial and desired.
- Ability to provide basic customer service – standing, greeting and working with volunteers.
- Ability to withstand long periods of sitting, standing and walking in all conditions indoors and outdoors.
- Ability to operate computers and basic audio-visual equipment.
- Ability to navigate basic social media platforms and other media platforms including the press and radio.
- Valid driver's license is preferred.
