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PREFACE

This document, *Finding Aid for the C.G.Sargent's Sons Company Records and Estate Documents, 1789 - 1954*, describes a group of photographs, advertisements, records of the Trustees of the Estate of C.G. Sargent, patents, deeds, maps and related plans pertinent to the manufacture of Wool Washing machinery. It was donated by Suzanne Wilder, Westford, MA. In 1994, and she was given permission to donate the materials to the Lowell Historical National Park. It was completed in November of 2008, and is the result of a project carried out for the Lowell National Historical Park by Cleo A. Ace, volunteer.

This finding aid lists the archival materials in the collection that Ms. Wilder donated to the park. The catalogued elements are defined in the Introduction to this Finding Aid. The original items are held in the Cultural Resources collections in the Curatorial Department.

Researchers are requested to contact the Curatorial Department for assistance in accessing and using this material

The donor gave all her rights to the collection to Lowell National Historical Park. This includes copyright to the letters written by the family. Copyright to items written by other individuals rests with the authors and their heirs for the period of the author's life plus seventy years, or for one hundred years from the date the items were created, if the author's date of death is unknown. INTRODUCTION

This finding aid describes materials in the C.G.Sargent's Sons Company Records and Estate Documents from 1798 - 1954. The collection consists of two photographs of F.G.Sargent, Trustee, and documents bundled by the Trustees of the Estate of C.G.Sargent, as well as patents, deeds, maps, advertisements, and plans of Wool Washing machinery.

F.G.Sargent was the son of Charles G. Sargent, and was the Trustee of the estate, as well as a principal in the company C.G.Sargent's Sons, Graniteville, MA., after the death of his father.

There are 5 Lantern Slide Transparencies cataloged as LOWE-5015 – LOWE 5017, and LOWE-6389 - LOWE- 6390.

Also cataloged are an additional 294 documents in records LOWE – 15751 through LOWE – 16049. Most of these are the technical drawings of plans for machinery related to washing wool and as technology progressed they were adapted to washing other materials. Two items are Boston newspapers containing the obituary of C.G.Sargent, July 16, 1878.
