

CAMP GOALS

- ◆ INSTILL THE VALUES OF PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY, HARD WORK, ENJOYMENT OF THE OUTDOORS, EDUCATION, AND RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT THROUGH A VARIETY OF CONSERVATION AND FARMING EXPERIENCES.
- ◆ PROVIDE EXPERIENCES THAT EXPAND YOUNG PEOPLE'S JOB SKILLS, LEADERSHIP ABILITIES, AND AWARENESS OF SOCIAL, POLITICAL, AND ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES.
- ◆ CONNECT MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS WITH LOCAL, STATE, AND NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS AND INDIVIDUALS THAT PROMOTE LAND STEWARDSHIP, SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE, AND AN AWARENESS OF PLACE.
