



Trail Closure Details

Forestry operations will occur in the southwest corner of Marsh-Billings-Rockefeller National Historical Park from February 2–March 2, 2026. Expect temporary trail closures and delays. Please observe and obey all posted signs.

The park will thin the Norway spruce plantation near the historic McKenzie farmstead to improve forest health and increase light for the adjacent historic apple orchard.

Established in 1950, Stand 13 has a long history of management to maintain views and forest structure. This project supports sustainable forestry and cultural landscape stewardship, enhancing ecological function and visitor experience along West Ridge Trail and the overlook approach.
