### **Rehabilitate Historic Mount Tom Forest as a Model of Sustainable Forest Management**

**Summary:** The Mount Tom Forest is the oldest managed forest in the United States and a demonstration of more than a century of conservation stewardship practices. The Forest is also one of the only federally-owned woodlands to be certified by the Forest Stewardship Council as a demonstration of responsible forestry. This project will rehabilitate eight of the 25 historic plantations, and develop a series of educational programs that offer visitors and school groups opportunities to explore and examine sustainable forest management practices.
