

Workshop leader Bill Stack is a forester and experienced shiitake grower from Hartland, Vermont. He has been growing shiitakes outside on logs for over ten years and helps operate Cobb Hill Mushrooms. This workshop will teach you how to grow shiitake mushrooms on logs. He'll cover everything from selecting the appropriate log species to picking and harvesting your own mushrooms.

If you have always wanted to try growing your own shiitakes this workshop offers a hands-on way to learn the skills and the needed tools and supplies to get you started. You will even get to bring home one inoculated shiitake log!

The workshop will also provide insights into site selection factors such as shading, terrain and wind protection; handling and care of logs during the resting and fruiting cycles; and cultivation processes to help ensure success outdoors at your home.
