### **Admission to Montezuma Castle and Tuzigoot National Monuments Free the Weekend of June 5 and 6**

In celebration of America's great outdoors, Montezuma Castle and Tuzigoot National Monuments will be joining national parks and wildlife refuges around the country in offering free admission to the monuments on Saturday and Sunday, June 5 and 6.

Visitors coming to Montezuma Castle and Tuzigoot on June 5 and 6 will be allowed to enter free of charge. Also, Western National Parks Association, the cooperating association which operates the book stores at both monuments, will be offering a 15% discount on all purchases on both days.

This summer's fee-free days are intended to encourage Americans to get outdoors and experience their public lands. Additional admission-free days are planned for August 14 and 15, September 25, and November 11.

Visitors to parks are reminded that the fee-free designation applies to entrance fees only and does not affect fees for camping, reservations, tours, or use of concessions at those national park units that have them. Monument visitor centers will have the Interagency Senior and Annual Passes available for those who wish to purchase them.
