## **Breastworks & Billboard Rocks**

Stop A-4

*View military remnants from the Utah War and rock inscriptions that advertised businesses during the 19th century.*



## **Big Mountain**

Stop A-17

*Emigrant trails meet from both sides of this viewpoint. View wagon swales, a monument, and beautiful mountain scenery!*



## **Little Dell Reservoir**

Stop A-20

*A Pony Express and stagecoach station used to lie at the site of this reservoir. An exhibit provides information.*



## **Mormon Flat**

Backcountry option #3

*Take a side trip on Jeremy Ranch Road to see exhibits, breastworks, and hiking trails along the historic trail route. Brigham Young's party camped here in July 1847.*
