



Permit for First Amendment Activities

A special use permit is required for public assembly or the sale or distribution of printed matter in National Park Service areas when group size is greater than 25.

Restrictions and Conditions

All First Amendment activities must take place at one of the areas designated for this purpose around the park. See the maps on this website or contact the permit coordinator for details.

All activities are limited to daylight hours.
All park regulations must be followed and no resource damage is allowed.

How to Apply

Complete an application form and return it by fax to the permit coordinator's attention or mail it to the following address. The application must be received a minimum of two working days prior to the time the activity will take place. The application should contain a statement of the goal of the organization and the proposed activity.
