Key Terms

MNI- minimum number of individuals

Provenience- refers to the geographical location where remains were originally discovered; their place of origin

Museum- any institution receiving Federal funds that has Native American human remains or cultural items in its collections

Notices- refers to notices of inventory completion published in the Federal Register
