Topic: NAGPRA Databases

Learn about the National NAGPRA online databases which are designed to provide access to information on a variety of NAGPRA-related topics such as:

- Native American Consultation Database (NACD), which identifies official contacts Indian tribes, Alaska Native villages and corporations, and Native Hawaiian organizations
- Published Federal Register Notices:
 - Notices of Inventory Completion for Native American human remains and associated funerary objects
 - Notices of Intent to Repatriate Cultural Items for unassociated funerary objects, sacred objects, and objects of cultural patrimony
- CUI Database, which contains the culturally unidentifiable (CUI) Native American human remains inventory information submitted by museums and Federal agencies

For those who have not participated in a webinar, you will need a computer with internet access and a phone (preferably a speaker phone). You will be taken through a written presentation on your computer and be able to hear, ask questions and participate in the discussion over the phone.
