**National NAGPRA Program FY 2013 Statistics at a Glance**  
For the period October 1, 2012 – March 31, 2013

**Inventories received:** 1,281 total from institutions, 266 reporting no collection

**Culturally Unidentifiable Native American Human Remains (CUI):** 742 inventories

- 121,436 Minimum Number of Individuals (MNI), 1,038,268 AFOs
- 4,740 MNI transferred as CUI dispositions; 6,331 MNI subsequently culturally affiliated

**Culturally Affiliated Native American Human Remains (CA):** 555 inventories

- 57,861 MNI, 1,246, 902AFOs

**Notices of Inventory Completion:** Published 43 in FY 2013, 1,662 in total

- account for 46,245 human remains and 1,117,033 Associated Funerary Objects (AFOs)
- no requests for extension of time to complete an inventory, no new requests in FY2013
- **Notices using the 10.11 rule:** Published 12 in FY 2013, 90 in total, account for 929 human remains, 1,634 AFOs (CUI also in notices using 10.16, prior to 10.11 and when 10.11 does not apply)

**Summaries received:** 1,580 total from institutions, 459 reporting no summary collection

**Notices of Intent to Repatriate:** Published 18 in FY 2013, 620 in total

- account for 211,853 Unassociated Funerary Objects (UFOs), 4,804 sacred objects, 7,749 objects of cultural patrimony, 1,460 objects both sacred and cultural patrimony, and 292 undesignated

**Notices of Intended Disposition** (Federal Agency newspaper notices of new discoveries)

- 1,376 Notices reported for 1,025 minimum number of individuals, 10,911 AFOs, 64 Unassociated Funerary Objects (UFO), and 4 objects of cultural patrimony

**Notice processing FY 2013:** 77 received, 61 published; aging drafts (pre-2007) 16 remaining
