● Akebono Cherry	<i>Prunus x yedoensis</i> 'Akebono'	single, pale pink flowers
● Takesimensis Cherry	<i>Prunus takesimensis</i>	single or double, white flowers
● Usuzumi Cherry	<i>Prunus spachiana</i> f. <i>ascendens</i>	single, white-grey flowers
▲ Weeping Japanese Cherry	<i>Prunus subhirtella</i> var. <i>pendula</i>	single or double, white to dark pink flowers
▲ Autumn Flowering Cherry	<i>Prunus subhirtella</i> var. <i>autumnalis</i>	single or double, white to dark pink flowers
▲ Sargent Cherry	<i>Prunus sargentii</i>	single, deep pink flowers
