



If you enjoy using public lands and want to help maintain them, consider spending a few hours with Natchez Trace Parkway staff on National Public Lands Day! Organized groups and individuals can help improve conditions along the Tupelo area section of the Natchez Trace National Scenic Trail through native seed collection, invasive non-native plant removal and trail rehabilitation. All participants will receive a coupon for free entry into any federal public land area that has an entrance fee.

When: Saturday, September 26, 2015, 8:00 am - 4:00 pm

Registration: Groups and individuals are encouraged to preregister for specific morning or afternoon tasks by September 20, 2015 by calling 662-680-4059 or 662-680-4027. Group size is limited for some tasks. Onsite registration for remaining tasks will be available Saturday, September 26, 8:00 am-2:00 pm at the Parkway Visitor Center, milepost 266, Tupelo, MS; 2 miles north of Highway 78.

What to wear and bring:

- Hat, long pants and long-sleeved shirt, work gloves, and rain gear if needed
- Bug repellent and sunscreen
- Closed toe shoes (no sandals or flip-flops, please)
- Lunch / snacks / water bottle

Children under 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
