

Dear CONSULTING PARTY:

The STATE AGENCY is responsible for administering the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) State Assistance Program (Public Law 88-578) on behalf of the National Park Service (NPS). This fund source provides matching grants to local, state, and tribal governments for the acquisition and development of public outdoor recreation areas and facilities. Grant recipients commit that they will manage funded areas for public outdoor recreation in perpetuity.
