

### ***STORM WARRIORS: THE STORY OF THE U.S. LIFE SAVING SERVICE***

The 55 minute film tells the dramatic story of shipwrecks and rescues in America's early Coast Guard, the United States Life Saving Service. According to the Third Wave Films web site, "These heroes of the surf used iron courage and super-human efforts to rescue ship wreck victims. Their story is told through the imaginative use of a re-created rescue, archival motion pictures, photographs, and interviews with historians. Local history buffs will be interested to note that the Coast Guard Academy got its start in New Bedford in 1877 with the Revenue Cutter School of Instruction located at the north end of Fish Island.
