

The Fishermen's Trail at Star Fort Pond



The Fishermen's Trail travels (distance) around Start Fort Pond and is marked by yellow blazes. The trail provides access to the pond at several points, but fishermen who go off-trail to the water's edge should be wary of snakes or stinging insects.

Rules and Regulations

Fishing is allowed at the Star Fort Pond from 30 minutes before sunrise and 30 minutes after sunset on Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays from April 1 to November 1. Anglers 16 years or older must possess a valid South Carolina fishing license. Snagging of fish and fishing with live minnows is not permitted. Alcoholic beverages and firearms of any kind are not permitted on the lake property. For the most up-to-date regulations please visit the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources at
